## PROJECT BACKGROUND

Over the last ten years, the Commission has become increasingly active in the field of Conflict Prevention and Peace Building (CPPB). This involvement, as well as the use of the articles 42 to 46 of the Common Security and Defence Policy (CSPD) of the Treaty on European Union are likely to further increase in the upcoming years.

The project will fulfill the agenda as laid out by the European Commission's Horizon 2020 strategy. It will review current understandings and training approaches related to conflict prevention and peace building and develop recommendations for new training methods in the field of military and civilian conflict prevention and peace building.
