Format

The Conference & Forum for Policy and Practice will be organised to foster effective and collaborative engagement, sharing of lessons, and participatory approaches to identifying next steps and improving the field. The Conference will include Panel Sessions with leading experts, practitioners and agencies, parallel workshops, design forums and collaborative innovation sessions, a 'market' space for training institutions and agencies to present and share their work, an IT 'space' for exploring ICT technologies and peace training, and more.
